During the COVID-19 pandemic, we are unable to always conduct face to face training courses, ensuring safe social distancing and meeting guidance issued by the UK Government and Public Health England.

However, recognising the need to continue to undertake training in certain areas we can offer a smaller number of courses remotely.

Course Delivery:

The training will be undertaken remotely, you will need to have access to a device(s) that meets the IT requirements below.

Remote training is carried out, up to four online sessions, plus additional sessions if required, through a video meeting/conferencing platform, at no additional cost to you, Monday to Thursday, for up to 2 hours a day.

You must attend all the training sessions to be able to enter the assessment on the Friday. The assessment is also carried out remotely, while connected to the online video meeting/conferencing platform but you must also be able to undertake the multiple-choice assessment electronically and submit via email. Full instructions will be provided.

Course IT Requirements

Each delegate will need a Windows or Mac PC, with built in or external camera. The course can also be delivered on a tablet, but we recommend at least a 10.5-inch screen. The assessment will use a web application, running on a standard web browser.

Cold Water Risk Assessment and Disinfection**Duration:** 10 hours plus home study **Location:** On-line**Cost:** £225 (members) £275 (non-members)**Course Overview:**

This course aims to train installers to properly design and maintain water systems to minimise the risks of Legionella bacteria growth and Legionnaires' disease. It looks at how to safely disinfect a water system and perform a risk assessment associated with cold and hot water systems.
